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This Indenture made and entered into the 11th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between William Henry of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Peter Edwards of the County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Henry having authority by a Vest in Trust created to him by Jacob Foster of the aforesaid County and State made the 15th day of October in the year of our Lord 1821 Whereas the said Jacob Foster did by the said Vest convey to him the said William Henry in Trust a certain parcel of Land containing 145 Acres for the express purpose of securing due and owing to the said Peter Edwards by the said Jacob Foster Sum of Twenty four and twenty cents the said Peter Edwards by and through the said William Henry and being on the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia Benjamin Blount being beginning at a Pine pine corner of William Foster in said tract thence along said William Foster line 12 1/2 E. S. 6. S. thence N. 11° E. 16. poles thence S. 28. 6. S. poles to a light wood Sub. Corner of Peter Edwards in said William Foster line thence along said Peter Edwards line S. 77 E. 10. poles thence S. 63 E. 17 poles to a Freshet thence S. 57 E. 60 poles to a pine thence S. 6 E. 32 poles to a small pine thence S. 89 E. 80 poles to a pine near a small branch Maple Corner of Peter Edwards in said Benjamin Blount line thence along said Blount line down the various courses of said branch to the Corn of Bents Grange thence down the various courses thereof to a black Gum tree Corner made between said Peter Edwards and the land of said Jacob Foster also thence along a new line of Markers thence N. 85 E. 60 poles to a light wood Stake near Corner of said Peter Edwards thence N. 12 E. 8 1/4 poles to the next station and the said William Henry in discharge of the duties imposed on him by the said Vest in Trust did duly advertise the sale of said land as directed by said Vest in Trust and sold it at Public Sale on the 15th of October 1820 and the said Peter Edwards then and there became the purchaser of said fifty acres of land conveyed in trust as aforesaid and every part and parcel thereof for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in the receipt of which he the said William Henry doth fully convey to him the said Peter Edwards the right title and estate which he the said William Henry had vested in him by the said Vest in Trust to him the said Peter Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and he the said William Henry doth warrant and defend the title of the said tract or parcel of land against him self and his heirs only in witness whereof he the said William Henry hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and date first within writing signed Seals and delivered in presence of
