Before the entering and delivery of the premises through which a conveyance was made and by the said parties a bargain was made and the said Henry Buggs has thus and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton of being the same that which was given by Henry Bolles dec'd in his will to the County of Southampton which said lands as of record in the County Court of Southampton and conveyed by the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife to the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife by a late conveyance by the name of the said tract belonging to the heirs of John Trebleman dec'd the lands of Richard H. Thomas and Eben or Hicks and the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises appertaining and improvements of every description comprehending and including the water right thereto with its mill race and premises unto them the said Henry Buggs his heirs and assigns forever and the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife further sever and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appertaining and improvements before mentioned and the said Henry Buggs has thus and assigns full power the claims or claims of them the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife their heirs and assigns of all and every kind and name whatsoever shall be and do warrant and forever defend by these presents a title of colour of the said James B. Hendall and Rozette his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
