This Indenture made this 15th day of September in the year 1823 between William Bell and Polly his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Cobb of the same County of the other part do hereby certify that the said William Bell and Polly his wife in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety nine dollars thirty five Cents Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Cobb at or before the making and delivery of this private the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Cobb his heirs and assigns a certain parcel or lot of land containing eighty six and a half acres being a part of the tract whereon the said Bell now lives and bounded as follows beginning at a line for an off line tree in the said Bell and Cobb line on the north part thence along the said line to a Elm on a small branch thence down the said branch to a pine marked line & off near the said branch on the said Bell line and the north part thence along the said line to the north end of a quarter corner thence down the said Bell branch to a blacked caprock at the junction of the narrow run of said branch and the run from the first gate of the said branch thence north 56 or 10 poles to Kendall's line thence along the said line to a run made corner (a dog wood for the said Bell and Cobb in the said Kendall's line thence a new line north 1. feet to a highway on the north part thence up the said Bell part to the beginning into the said Samuel Cobb his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging and the said William Bell and Polly his wife for them selves their and each of their heirs heirs and assigns in water the said tract or parcel unto him the said Samuel Cobb his heirs or assigns shall and well forever warrant and defend.
