This Indenture made the 25th day of September in the year 1792 between Nicholas Williams and Anne Brown of the one part
 and Edward Bates of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby certify that whereas the said Nicholas
 Williams and by a certain deed bearing date August 23rd 1786 did and convey to Anne Brown a certain tract or
 parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and which said land has been proved by one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and
 by the Clerk of said County of Southampton and hath not since been fully proved and admitted of record And the said Anne
 Brown having paid to the said Edward Bates the tract above mentioned and the said Nicholas Williams being owing
 to make the title good to the said Edward Bates then therefore the said Nicholas Williams for the consideration of
 and the said Anne Brown for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and fifty dollars in hand paid
 by the said Edward Bates the receipt whereof the said Anne Brown doth hereby acknowledge and which said sum
 and value is expressed and by these presents doth give bargain and sell unto the said Edward Bates his heirs assigns
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty four acres lying and being in the County of Southampton
 and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak in Dryden's field line into Robert Gooden's and
 land at the side of the road then along the same's corner of said road to a white oak in Edward Bates' land formerly
