This Indenture made this 27 day of January 1824 between Richard Buck a freeholder of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part James Richelle of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the second part and Arthur Middleton of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said Richard Buck stands jointly indebted to the said James Vaughan in the sum of fifty dollars for which he has given a bond for payment of the same at the rate of ten percent interest bearing date with these presents and to the said James Richelle for the sum of fifty dollars due by note on demand the 25 day of December next which said note bears interest with these presents and the said Richard Buck being willing and desirous effectually to discharge the said James Vaughan and James Richelle by payment of the aforesaid sum of money with the interest growing thereon and also for the further Consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred pounds by the said Arthur Middleton the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged both granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Arthur Middleton his heirs executors and administrators one bay mare one saddle gelding an arquebus one yoke carts and wheels two hores and three steeds of cattle twenty two head of hogs five Head of sheep and all the stock of every description plantation utensils of every kind his house hold's kitchen furniture of all sorts and kinds etc in Corn fodder and Gravel them on hand and also Pork bacon and Bacon smokin on hand and also all the Crops of every kind nature and description which the said Richard Buck may or shall make this year and also all the property goods effect of every kind which the said Richard Buck is now possessed of or may be possessed of during this year to have and to hold the aforesaid property of every kind and description to him the said Arthur Middleton his executors and administrators upon this Special Trust and Conference that is today of the said Richard Buck shall punctually pay to the said James Vaughan the said sum of Fifty dollars with the interest accruing thereon when the same shall be demanded by the said James Vaughan his heirs executors and administrators and to the said James Richelle the aforesaid sum of Fifty dollars or on or before the 25 day of October next when and in that case the said Arthur Middleton his heirs executors and administrators and will be liable to the said Richard Buck a full and complete discharge of all and every part and parcel of the aforesaid property but in case the said Richard Buck shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt on or before the time aforesaid as above set and in that case it shall be compelled for the said Arthur Middleton his executors and administrators at the request of either the said James Vaughan or the said James Richelle their heirs executors and administrators or either of them take possession of the aforesaid property or any part thereof wheresoever found either in the possession of the said Richard Buck or any other person whomsoever and after satisfying the said property at the Court House door Mr. Clarke see the Same to the highest bidder for cash or so much thereof as will be sufficient to pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt and the interest thereon that may accrue on the drawing recording and carrying into execution of this trust and the surplus of any sum to be paid to the said Richard Buck his heirs executors and administrators and may be required for the said Arthur Middleton his executors and administrators immediately upon the death of the said Richard Buck to take possession of every part and parcel thereof the aforesaid property and make sale of the same after giving notice as aforesaid for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale to pay and satisfy the debt aforesaid and costs aforesaid and the surplus of any sum over as aforesaid and it is moreover agreed and understood between the parties to this present that the said Arthur Middleton his heirs executors and administrators may at any time at the request of the said James Vaughan or on the said James Richelle their heirs executors and administrators take possession of the said property whereupon James Vaughan aforesaid of the sum according to the terms of their presents unto the said Richard Buck for himself his heirs executors and administrators and will forever warrant and defend the right of both to the aforesaid property and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Arthur Middleton his heirs executors and administrators against them heirs executors and administrators
