Brock and Polly his wife and Poley Drake both all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia and Parish of Solomon of the one part & James Rhytha of the same County State and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas E. Brock Polly his wife and Poley Drake for and in consideration of the sum of twenty one dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James Rhytha the receipt whereof the said Thomas E. Brock Polly his wife and Poley Drake do hereby acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid that grantors bargain and sell aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell confirm unto the said James Rhytha his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County State and Parish aforesaid and adjoining the said James Rhytha's land whereon he now lives containing by a late survey ten acres and a half and bounded as follows to-wit Beginning at a Pine in Benjamin Messer's line and a run Corner of James Rhytha's thence along a line of run markers to wit 23 E 68 pole to just beyond a fore and aft Sacrifice in said line thence N 13 E 1 pole to a highland post a run Corner of said James Rhytha's thence along on the side of the road leading from Blackwater bridge to Jerusalem thence up said road N 76 E 35 pole to the intersection of the said Road and a small branch thence down the said branch thence across thereof to a corner of John Drake's line and Benjamin Messer's line N 60 E 1 pole to the station to which with all houses out houses edifices buildings grass garden orchard swamp water and water courses whatsoever belonging or on any mode appertaining to the said lot and premises to have and to hold the same unto the said James Rhytha to him and to his heirs forever and the said Thomas E. Brock Polly his wife and Poley Drake doth for them and their heirs executors and assigns confirm and grant to and with the said James Rhytha his heirs if appears that they sell by their presents warrant and defend all right title claim or demand of any person persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof in witness whereof the said Thomas E. Brock Polly his wife and Poley Drake have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date written lasten
