Now all now by these presents that I Peter Barrett of the County of Southampton our State of Virginia for & in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to Henry Thundor of the County and State aforesaid as well as for his further Consideration of me due to me in hand paid by the said Henry Thundor in sum two hundred & one thousand dollars before the induction and delivery of these presents he receipt whereof is fully acknowledged & acknowledged and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Henry Thundor the sum aforesaid and agree a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County Southampton containing by estimation forty acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a Black Oak Corner of Ewan Bryant then E to a post oak then N to Cullen park Corner with Geo. Williams then S east to a Maple tree to a post oak corner with the said Williams then S to a red oak rightwood post corner against the said George Williams then N to a pine tree post oak corner then N to a Basswood then N to a red oak then N to a maple tree then N to the said black Oak corner with the said Ewan Bryant To have and to hold the said Land with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said Henry Thundor his heirs & executors and assigns forever and the said Peter Barrett and family for himself his wife and adue the sum of £1000 and all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Henry Thundor his heirs & executors and assigns against the claim of him the said Peter Barrett his executors and assigns and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents In testimony whereof I the said Peter Barrett have signed set my hand and seals this 25th day of January 1824

that the said Joseph Teller for and consideration of £1000 and ten dollars English
money of Virginia in hand paid the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged back granted bargained
sold and by these presents duly granted Bryan and sold unto the said Marion Bryan and to
his heirs and assigns all that plantation house or parcel of Land in the County of Southampton
between Mervin Bryan and formerly lived except on an island in the Mervin River more
standard containing by estimation one hundred and twenty acres to the same more or
less which is in the Mervin County and Conformed unto the said Joseph Teller
by a deed in trust to secure the payment of a debt due to James Scott bearing date July 6/1819
and to die as by the known and upland bound thereof to have and to hold the said lands & houses
