This Indenture made this 18th day of March anno Domini 1824 Between William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife of the Town of Tuckerton of the one part And Thomas Person of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife for and consideration of the sum of Forty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Person before the sealing and delivery of these presents In receipt whereof is fully acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and enfeoffed to the said Thomas Person his heirs and assigns forever to lots of ground in the Town of Monroe in the County of Southampton one of which said lots is Person and designated as the Map or plat of said lot as Lot No 8 And extends on Jacksons Tract from Pittman Road to the front of Madison Street thence up Madison Street thirty four yards to a corner stone thence to the river at the waters edge at a point thence down the river on the edge of the water to the beginning supposed to contain half an acre to be the same more or less and also one other lot situated and known in the plan of said Town by Number twenty four containing no acre and bounded as follows to wit on the south by Washingtons street on the west by Pittmans street on the north by Madison street and on the east by Williams Ricks and Clements Roselle and the reverend Mr. Parsons remainder and remains of all and singular the said lots of land and premises freely granted or mentioned or intended to be freely granted and of every part and parcel thereof and also all and every the whole and estates rights titles claims and demands whatsoever of them the said William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife unto or out of the said lots of ground and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said lots of ground and all other the premises freely granted bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be freely granted bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Thomas Person his heirs and assigns forever And the said William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife do freely grant for him and his heirs that they the said William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife and their heirs the said the lots of ground and premises freely granted or mentioned to be granted unto every part and parcel thereof with all and singular their and every of their right members and appurtenances unto the said Thomas Person his heirs and assigns against whom the said William A. Gaspert and Martha his wife and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming by through or under them shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said William
