Lawrence in the division of her Father's estate all of which do presume will more fully appear
by the report of the Surveyors making partition together with the remains and remains remainder and
sum and yearly and other rents, issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold
the said lands, tenements, hereditaments with all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended
to be bargained and sold with any of their rights members and appurtenances unto him the said John
