Smith of the State of Alabama and County of Standard all which is of record in the County Court of Southampton and State of North Carolina hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five dollars to me in hand paid by James Jackson of Southampton County and State of Virginia sold to said James Jackson on behalf of said Deary to said Joseph P. D. Smith in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing three hundred and eleven acres bounded as follows (By beginning in Tracts Branch N. 36 East 236 poles along Benjamin Blunt's line to a corner pine in James Blunt's line thence along his line N. 47 W. 185 poles to a corner white oak in Short's line thence S. 88 W. 40 poles thence S. 83 W. 36 poles thence S. 70 W. 11 poles to a maple in a small branch thence down the main run of said branch to Trunk's branch thence down the main run of Trunk's branch to the first station and I the said John Deary for the Consideration above mentioned do warrant and defend as attorney for said Smith the right and title of said Land with all appurtenances thereto belonging his heirs and assigns forever.
