and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and five dollars to me on hand paid by James  
Jackson of Southampton County and State of Virginia doth to say James Jackson on tract  
of land belonging to said Joseph P. D. Smith in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia  
containing three hundred and eleven acres bounded as follows By beginning in Smith's branch  
A. 20. East 236 poles along Benjamin Plant's line to a corner pine in James Smith's  
line thence along his line A. 247 West 100 poles to a corner white oak in Smith's line thence 50  
1040 poles thence S 73 W 36 poles thence S 70 W 11. poles to a maple in a small branch  
thence down the main run of said branch to Smith's branch thence down the main run of Smith's  
branch to the first stream and then said Allen Peterry for the consideration above mentioned doth
