This Indenture made this 23rd day of March A. D. 1824 Between John Shepherd of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Gray of the aforesaid County & State of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Shepherd in order to secure the payment of the following debt viz. on written obligation under the hand and seal of the said John Shepherd executed to Lewis Harris on the 23 day of the present month (March) as above stated for the sum of Two hundred and fifteen dollars and 25 cts. on demand &c. the said John Shepherd sold grant bargain and sell unto the said John Gray the following property viz. One breeding Horse and a Set of Scales on which the said Horse should Containing Eleven & three fourths acre together with all and singular and other appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the same four head of Horses one Sowing and one young Cattle one or more of John Everett of Bedford County, North Carolina one Secretary and Port Case two Walnut Tables Simlins Windsor Chairs the Sorting glasse One feather bed and furniture. The Hare and to have the said bargain and sell perfectly unto him the said John Gray his heirs executors and assigns forever. This Indenture made this 27th day of June in the year 1823 between Joseph Drum of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and Edwin W. Claud of said County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Drum being pretty indebted to the said Edwin W. Claud of the said County and State in the sum of three hundred dollars Benjamin money due by bonds with sufficient interest from this date and being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the same to the said Edw. W. Claud in consideration whereof and moreover for an increase of the sum of one dollar in hand paid the receipt whereof is fully fully acknowledged by the said Joseph Drum had given granted bargain and sold and by these presents do hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Edwin W. Claud his heirs and assigns forever the following property viz. one acre of land for the purpose of the said Joseph Drum being indebted for the said Edwin W. Claud his heirs and assigns for the purpose of paying the said Joseph Drum the sum of three hundred dollars secure the said Joseph Drum should make default therein it is hereby agreed and declared to be the true intent and meaning of this Indenture that if the said sum as before specified be not paid clearly paid unto the said Edw. W. Claud with all interest thereon on or before the 25 day of December
