This Indenture made this 6th day of December in the year of our Lord 1825 between John Warren and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part. Benjamin L. Drew of said County of the second part and Ruffin Hart of the same County of the third part. - Whereas it is agreed between the said John Warren and the said Ruffin Hart that the said Ruffin Hart also within land to one hundred and forty three dollars & pence on demand the first day of January next and right pur a kind of one hundred forty three dollars ten cents on demand the first day of January 1825 going & payable money of Virginia. The said John Warren and Martha his wife being desirous of making the said Ruffin Hart bear on the payment thereof for his further consideration of one dollar to them on hand paid by the said Benjamin L. Drew he receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Warren and Martha his wife both grants bargains sells, alienes and leases released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, alien and release and confirm to the said Benjamin L. Drew the sum and apiece forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton now formerly belonging to the said Ruffin Hart and sold by him to the said John Warren for the sum above mentioned Enduring by a late Survey forty seven and one half acres to the Southwardly to him and to have the like grants, powers with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said premises and either of them the said S. Drew his heirs and assigns forever to bear and discharge the sum of one dollar to the said Benjamin L. Drew his heirs etc shall at the request of the said Ruffin Hart his heirs etc to proceed after the first day of January 1825 to sell so much of the said tract tract or parcel of Land as will discharge the first sum above named and the expenses of the sale thereof after advertising the same at least ten days and at the request of the said Ruffin Hart his heirs etc to proceed after the first day of January 1826 to sell the balance of the said tract or parcel of Land after advertising the same at least ten days to discharge the last sum above mentioned and after discharging the said sum and after paying all the expenses attending the sale of the premises pay to the said John Warren his heirs etc amount or apiece the balance of any.
