sum of Eighteen dollars to them on hands paid by the said Lewis Coopdale at an before the Indenture followed  
here presents the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged by the said Hardy Parke and Elizabeth his wife for  
themselves their heirs wife and a day here grants bargains and sells all and enfeoffeth and Conveyeth and  
by these presents do grant bargain alien and Convey unto the said Lewis Coopdale his heirs and assigns  
for ever a certain lot of land lying and being on the lower branch of Tuckahoe River and  
County of Accomack containing by estimation six acres to the same more or less within the following bounds to  
wit Beginning at a tree a corner tree standing on the north east side of a swamp or head which runs  
west North east side of the said Parke plantation on William Cullen and to a stake and a corner in  
Okanaw Hollens and thence along said Cullen line to a sapling a corner tree standing  
straight line of now marked trees to a bushing tree or corner standing in the aforesaid swamp  
or from thence by a straight line to the beginning to have and to have the said lot or piece of Land  
with all its appurtenances to him the said Lewis Coopdale his heirs and assigns forever and by the said  
Hardy Parke and Elizabeth his wife forthundered and their heirs executors and administrators to and unless  
they present warrant and forever defend the said Bargained premises and its appurtenances against the  
lawful claim or demand of all and every person wheresoever to have the said Lewis Coopdale his heirs and
