in the said decree mentioned after having legally advertised the same and that the said
Convinced Convey the Lands so sold to the purchaser in fee and that the said Convinced
also one fourth of such sale to William St Brigg's the Conplainant and one fourth to Richd
Hornington in right of his wife Nancy on fourth to Fanny St Brigg's and the remaining
fourth part to another Nancy St Brigg's as aforesaid James Edwards became the purchaser of
