This Indenture made this 5th day of March 1824 between Samuel Cobb & Edward Bates
 of the one part and James Edwards of the other part. Whereas by a decree of the County Court of
 Southampton on the 16th day of February 1824 in a Cause therein depending between William
 St. Briggs plaintiff and Thomas Rodley late Sheriff of Southampton County Spencer Tenn
 and Emily his wife Richard Storrington and Chaney his wife late Chaney Briggs
 Chaney Briggs and Rebecca Longe Briggs defendants. It was decreed and ordered that
 the said Samuel Cobb and Edward Bates Commissioners on the plaintiff's behalf mentioned
 should at Public Auction on a Credit of Twelve Months make sale of certain Lands
 in the said decree mentioned after having legally advertised the same and that the said
 Commissioners being the Lands so sold to the purchaser in fee and that the said Commissioners
 allot one fourth of such sale to William St. Briggs the complainant one fourth to Richard
 Storrington in right of his wife Chaney one fourth to Chaney Briggs and the remaining
 fourth part to Rebecca Longe Briggs as whole sale. James Edwards became the purchaser of
 the Lands mentioned in said decree at the price of seven hundred and fifty seven shillings and
 pence he has secured to be paid before the meeting and delivery of the same. The intention
 was that the said Samuel Cobb and Edward Bates as well for a consideration
 as aforesaid as of the sum of one dollar to them by the said James Edwards in
 grants. Whereas the said Cobb and Bates by their private and personal bargain with
