This Indenture of assignment made and executed this twentieth day of April on the year
 of our said one thousand eight hundred and twenty four Between Spencer Treves of the one
 part and James Hynds of the other part both of the County of Norfolk and State of Virginia
 Witnesses that the said Spencer Treves for and in consideration of the debt which he owes the
 said James Hynds one of the further consideration of four dollars to him in hand paid by
 the said James Hynds that he assigns transfers and do over and by these presents doth hereby assign
 transfers and do over unto him the said James Hynds to his own proper use of behoof full use
 and whatsoever the right title interest property or estate which he the said Spencer Treves in
 right of his late Emily formerly Emily Briggs hath into the undivided for third of the
 estate of Henry Briggs of the County of Southampton the former husband of the said Emily
 more particularly of all right or interest which the said Spencer Treves may have or right of
 his said wife to that part or portion of said estate which Maria one of the children of the
 said late Emily by her former husband Henry Briggs was entitled to the said Maria
 having departed this life before a division of the said estate and also the said Spencer Treves
 doth hereby assign unto the said James Hynds the balance due to him in right of his said
 wife as executrix of her former husband as respects to the also aforesaid settlement of their debts
 before a Commissioner appointed for that purpose by the Court of the said County of Southamp-
 ton and also the following open accounts to wit the one against Samuel Cobb the
 executor of the estate of Henry Briggs for the bond of Matthew Briggs of place of the said James
 Briggs for the year 1821 the sum of thirty dollars the other for the sum of fifteen
 dollars and fifty cents for bond of said Matthew Briggs from 1st January to 25th April 1822 likewise
