This Indenture made the 17th of April in the year of our Lord Christ eighteen hundred and twenty
four between Charles Woolfson one of the Justices of the Peace of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia of the one part and Christ Henry of the said County and State of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Charles Woolfson and Charles his wife for and in the name and on behalf
of the son of John Cobb and for and on behalf and for the use and behoof of the said Charles
is born in his said son or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
We the said Charles Woolfson and Charles his wife do hereby acknowledge to be
granted Benjamin and his heirs and assigns into the said Christ Henry and to the
him and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and fifty
four acres and is being part of a Tract of Land belonging to the late Henry
Perryman lying in the aforesaid County and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at
a certain corner of Richard and Henry Perryman line to the said Henry Perryman line to
a point in Thomas Perryman line along the line to Richard Perryman line thence along the line to
beginning containing one hundred and forty four acres and a half more or less. Or there and to
the said one hundred and forty four acres and a half land with all and singular the appur-
tenances therunto belonging unto him the said Christ Henry his heirs and assigns
forever to the use and behoof of him the said Christ Henry his heirs and
assigns forever and the said Charles W. Woolfson and Charles his wife their heirs
of their heirs and assigns forever and forever defend the aforesaid mentioned Land of premises
