John Indenture made the 11th day of April in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen hundred and twenty four between Eliza Atkinson and Rebecca her wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Henry Fowler of the said County and State of Virginia part. Witness that the said Eliza Atkinson and Rebecca her wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars of gold and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid on a before the acknowledged delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Eliza Atkinson and Rebecca her wife each being at that time duly granted bargained and sold aliened and conveyed unto the said Henry Fowler and to his heirs and assigns forever an certain tract or parcel of Land containing ten acres situate part of a tract of Land belonging to the late Dr. Travell and lying in the aforesaid County and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Corner between said Fowler's land shown a point Marked a line of Mark's line to a post oak in said Fowler's land shown a double Mark Corner to a Chestnut in said Fowler's land shown East. Corner to the beginning containing ten acres more or less to have and to hold the said ten acres of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry Fowler his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Henry Fowler his heirs & assigns forever and the said Eliza Atkinson and Rebecca her wife their heirs heirs and assigns shall warrant and forever defend the aforesaid matters lands and premises unto the said Henry Fowler his heirs & assigns forever against the claim or title of all person or persons whatsoever.
