Kitchen furniture and all the plantation utensils with the stock of all kind and
Crop of all kinds to have and to hold the said property above mentioned to the said
Sally Cooper during her Winters and Colds I the said Howell Scarborough do warrant
the title of the said property to the said Sally Cooper against any person or persons whatsoever
during Winters and Colds after her Winters and Colds to whom it may chuse to be given in
my will directed as aforesaid my hand and seal 1st day of November 1833.

This Indenture made this Eleventh day of February on the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty four Edward Hardy Rants and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
Johnathan Boggsdale of the said County and State of Virginia of the other part. Now therefore both the said
Hardy Rants and Elizabeth his wife acknowledge of the sum of Eighteen dollars to have in hand
paying to the said Johnathan Boggsdale above before he executed and delivered of their presents the receipt whereof
they the said Hardy Rants and Elizabeth do hereby acknowledge and being former servants ought and ready
from the said Johnathan Boggsdale to him that now and aye have grants bairns and six slaves employed Captain
and by these presents do grant to the said Johnathan Boggsdale and his heirs and executors the said Johnathan Boggs-
dale and his heirs forever a certain piece of land containing six acres to be known more
or less Edward and Henry in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and contain
the following bounds beginning at a single corner tree of Somme Dauphin a few rods off a stone
wall and then thence a due line of marker trees on the said Dauphin line to a high bank past a corner
of the said Bank and of the said Rants then a run line of marker trees to a dead tree a corner of which
lands then a run line of marker trees to said Dauphin line then as back a corner of which is instead
said wall and then a due line of marker trees to the first station and so round may make
perfect Commissioner's line stations and appurtenances unto the same belonging or in any wise affording
title together with the houses and conveniences thereunto and whatsoever else of value there is and all
the estate rights title interest claim or demands of the said Hardy and Elizabeth his wife next to the
same. To have and to hold the said lands and premises with the appurtenances unto them the said Johnathan
Boggsdale his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edward Rants and Elizabeth his wife shall forth
from warrant and defend the said lands and premises against the claiming demands of all
persons whatsoever to whom it may belong the said Edward Rants and Elizabeth his wife have bound to
them hands and seals the day and year first above written
