Battle both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witness that the said Abraham Battle for and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand Dollars to him in hand paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt and prayer with be 15th October 1824 doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell set over and confirm unto him the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns all the said Abraham Battle's right title interest claim or demand which he now has or may hereafter have at the death of his mother or and to a certain tract of Land which his Father Eppa Battle did seize and possess (Containing by estimation Six hundred and fifty acres to the same more or less and lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the South Side of Hollway River and bounded by the said River the State line the Lands of James Battle of the one part and the said tract of Land is now in the possession of his mother Eppa Battle to have and to hold the said bargain premises to him the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns forever together with all and singular the appurtenances and profits thereto in anywise incident to the same in any manner belonging or in any wise appertaining and the said Abraham Battle doth for himself his heirs and assigns hereby warrant and defend the right title true Convey of the said tract of Land to him the said William R. Battle his heirs and assigns against the claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever.
