This Indenture made this 27th day of December in the year of our Lord 1823 between Symon Joyner and Eliza his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Symon Joyner of the same County and State of the second part witnesseth that the said Eliza Joyner and Symon Joyner doth for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Eliza Joyner upon the receipt whereof the said Symon Joyner and Eliza his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and affid to have sold and gave unto the said Eliza Joyner two acres and a half of land and premises situated in the County of Southampton and on the south side of Black Creek adjoining the said Eliza Joyner containing by late Survey made by the County Surveyor Thomy Sherriff 1/2 acre in the same river & left and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small black tree on a run of the River Joyner and so in a straight line in the said purchase of Eliza Joyner then at 20° E. 62' pole to a fence corner on the line abounding in small trees thence down the same course of the said branch to the main Run of Black Creek then up the Creek the various courses thereof a 20' wide made on said line between Eliza Joyner then a number of smaller trees E. 36° E. 71' pole to a fence & next made the said Eliza Joyner and Eliza Joyner standing on the side of a tall tree along that path at 70° E. 12' pole to the first Eliza Joyner and all houses or houses belonging thereto standing on the same and under course of hollow belonging to my wife appertaining to her and to hold the same unto her said Eliza Joyner to have and to hold the same to her and Eliza Joyner and Eliza Joyner her self & her executors and administrators unto her present, current and grant to and with the said Eliza Joyner the same and of joyner had they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demands of my person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof having of the said Eliza Joyner and Eliza Joyner his wife hereinafter their hands and affid their seals this day and year wherein written.

This Indenture made this 10th day of April in the year of our Lord 1824 between John Byffle Esq. and Eliza his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Solomon Byffle of the aforesaid County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said John Byffle to the said Eliza his wife in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Eliza Byffle upon the receiving and delivery of these presents she receipt whereof is fully acknowledged has bargained and sold and by these presents doth give and sell unto the said Eliza Byffle Two acres and a half of land in a certain tract or parcel of Land together with all the improvements thereunto belonging situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and being the same which the said Solomon Byffle now resides containing one hundred
