and delivered and by these presents with William Jones and confirmed unto the said Nathaniel Jones  
and to his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by Survey three acres and a half acres (45)  
in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows beginning at a point on a Creek between said lands & Nathaniel
