forty two between George B. Edmunds and Elizabeth his wife of the one part. Horace Edmunds of the other part  
all of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina witnesseth that he and George B. Edmunds  
and Elizabeth his wife for and consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them or her paid  
or secured to be paid by the said Horace Edmunds above before the issuing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof the said George B. Edmunds and Elizabeth his wife doth fully acknowledge and forever  
accept and discharge the said Horace Edmunds of the same. Which granted bargained and sold and by the  
foremost doth grant bargain sell and Confer unto the said Horace Edmunds by a certain undivided  
portion of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia the said  
being that portion of Land which he above mentioned Elizabeth Edmunds was entitled to have to be  
of the Lands of her and further Horace Edmunds which were situated in the County of Southampton  
and State of Virginia as aforesaid also the mowers and reeverses thereon and commoner rights with  
all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said said  
Horace Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever and he the said George B. Edmunds & Elizabeth his  
wife doth testify for ourselves on his own word and of his own accord and agree to and with the  
said Horace Edmunds to warrant our aforesaid after the right and title to the above granted prop-  
erty against the claim of the said any Person and or persons whatever In witness  
whereof the said George B. Edmunds and Elizabeth Edmunds his wife hath this day set her hand
