It is known to all whom I may concern that I Mary Ann Wilson of the County of Southampton Suffolk
 the said Ann at Law of Frederick Wilson dec'd. was taken into the care and protection of my Stepfather Doctor
 Carr's House when I was about two years of age: until the death of my father Captain Mills deceased and
 War with Wilson, which happened, the first about the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifteen
 (having no the following) began to let Jacob Peter Henry Esq. my and Peter the latter about the
 year eighteen hundred and fourteen from whom I hired a negro woman Delina but did not get her
 until just before the year eighteen hundred and nineteen by and in consequence of a legal decision
 upon which decision my Stepfather paid the sum of eight Dollars due from me to this she has
 I had no second care the rest of my said which was quite considerable before and now I
 to Henry for delay passing from the period at which the Doctor took the management of me and
 of my estate to the present time he has furnished me board, clothing and education at an expense to him
 much more than the profits of my estate and for all which I have never paid to him any thing. He
 has had the management of the property which I claim as the wife of the deceased Mills
 deceased and as an heir at Law of Frederick Wilson And I am very sure has behaved towards
 it that attention which was necessary such as my Stepfather has very kindly agreed to make
 me charge for any sum retained for my board or for any thing which he has done for me other
 than what he has received for the care of my said and the hire of my negro. I do not wish to release
 him from any demand or claim which I have against him as my husband or as my father
 my whole law being declaring that I have received full and ample satisfaction from him and his
 own attorney that as this day I have received from my said Guardian the following items to wit
 Jacob Peter Henry Esq. my and Peter the latter about the year eighteen hundred and
 Delina with a child is being her receipt from the receiver of Frederick Wilson negroes which I hired
 from the said War with Wilson and my friends (my father and my father's friends) called to me
 and Wilson who place evidence of my Master's right And I do also agree to him from my
 claim or demand of which I have in him as one of the deceased Mills deceased in testimony
 whereof I have written all my hand and Seal this 29th day of Oct. 1823
