 die before the said Maria C. Everett and should have no issue living at the time of her
 Maria C. Everett's death that he will convey the said negroes to the children of William
 and Maria C. Everett or such of them as then be to them and their heirs forever

 one part and Richard Buckle a free man of Color of the other part Witnesseth that the
 said Samuel Calcutt for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in
 hand paid the receipt whereof a duly attested copy has been given and signed and
 attested and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Richard Buckle his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County of Southampton and shown as a well known place by a
