This INDENTURE made and entered into this 2^d day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty four between James Pleyte of Southampton County Burgess of the first part and James Mappinburg of the same County
 and State of the same part and James D. Mappinburg of the same County and State of the third part New York
 that whereas the said James Pleyte the day of the 3^d day of April last executed a certain Bond to the said James
 Mappinburg for the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of New York a certain Matthew Geddes
 became his security to the said Bond for the payment of the above mentioned Debt which said Bond is on
 demand the 25th December next but carries interest from the execution of the same bond Now the said James Pleyte
 being desirous to more effectually secure the payment of the said debt to him the said D. Mappinburg but more
