This Indenture made this 29th day of May 1827 between Lewis Pick of the first part John Barrett of the same part and Lewis Morrell of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Lewis Pick is fully indebted unto the said Lewis Morrell by note bearing date with these presents the sum of three hundred and twenty three dollars & 00cts and the said Lewis Pick being willing and desirous to secure the said Lewis Morrell the payment thereof together with the legal interest thereon according and also the cost of attorney's fees and carrying of the premises and also for the further Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said John Barrett the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold unto by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land & being the part of the Land and plantation wherein Grover Wick lived on and also being the dwelling house lot of land allotted to me now by my father at his death supposed to be thirty acres to the same more or less also eight acres purchased of John Pick and bounded the same can be more appear by reference from the deed from John Pick to Lewis Pick to Howard & Pick the aforesaid land as aforesaid unto him the said John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis Pick for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth covenant and agree with the said John Barrett that he will from time and at times forever hereafter warrant and defend the title of the said Land as aforesaid unto him the said John Barrett his heirs & assigns forever upon specific trust and confidence nevertheless and to and for the uses intents and purposes following that is to say that the said John Barrett may and shall at any time hereafter whensoever he shall be therunto requested by either of the parties unto this sale of the said land as aforesaid publick sale giving at least fifteen days last books notice at the aforesaid place for ready money and at the price of twelve pds of starch salt pay unto the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum of three hundred twenty five dollars & 00cts together with the growing timber thereon and costs as aforesaid carryings and charges present and the overplus of any pay over unto the said Lewis Pick or his order In witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixes their seals the day and year wherein written sealed and delivered in presence of
