property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County  
of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick house or store for cash and out of the money so  
taken from the said sale in the first place pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expense  
attending the said Conveyance and then pay off the debts aforesaid with interest as well as all other
