Edmund one thousand Eight hundred and forty three Between Charles Edmund Benjamin
Edmund and Elizabeth Johnson their wife of William Edmunds died of North Carolina
of the one part and Edmund Edmunds of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Charles and Benjamin Edmunds and Elizabeth
Johnson for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars
current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Edmund Edmunds the
receipt whereof the said Charles and Benjamin Edmunds and Elizabeth Edmund
hath acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and convey unto the said Edmund Edmunds and his heirs and aforesaid a certain
parcel or lot of Land Containing by estimation Eighty acres to the same more or
less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia as follows and
known in the plot and report of the division of the land of Edmund Edmunds
described by Lot No 3 and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a white oak a mow tree
made in Lot No 3 go on the Mill pond side running thence S 57 E 19 2 pole to
a lighthead Stock a mow corner made in Lot No 2 & 5 thence S 54 W 10 7 pole to a
small pine a new corner made in Lot No 3 & 7 thence N 57 E 19 2 pole to
