This Indenture made this 28 day of October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty three Between Charles Edmund Benjamin Edmunds and Elizabeth Johnson heirs of William Edmunds deceased of the one part and Edmund Edmunds of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Charles and Benjamin Edmunds and Elizabeth Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Edmund Edmunds the receipt whereof the said Charles and Benjamin Edmunds and Elizabeth Edmunds have acknowledged both goods lawfully sold and conveyed and by their presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Edmund Edmunds and his heirs and assigns a certain full parcel or lot of land containing by estimation eighty acres in the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia as aforesaid and shown in the plot and report of the division of the lands of Edmund Edmunds deceased by Col. W. S. and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak a new corner made in Lot No 3 of the Mule Pond and running thence S 75° E 192 feet to a light colored stone a new corner made in Lot No 3 of the same S 15° W 70 feet to a small pine a new corner made in Lot No 3 of the same S 15° W 101 feet to a
