This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty four between John  
John Blow of the first part William P. Everett of the second part and Matthias Williams of the third part  
all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth Whereas John Blow being ready  
intended to Matthias Williams Representations of David Wilson died in the just and full sum of  
sixty dollars due to him bearing equal date with these presents and on demand the day after  
due and being willing and desirous to deem the same unto Matthias Williams his heirs &c  
blow this day granted bargained sold made over and confirmed and by these presents do give  
grant bargain sell make over and deliver unto William P. Everett and his Representatives  
and his successors of any dollar to him in hand paid by the said William  
P. Everett the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following property to wit one  
Bay mare one Cart and Vehicle Two beds and furniture one Cow and Calf one or Two Sows  
and pigs and Eight Sheep And he the said John Blow warrants and forever defends the  
aforesaid property against the claim and demand of all and every other person or persons unto  
him the said William P. Everett and his Representatives & his heirs & successors  
that the said Everett shall upon the request of either of the above named parties John Blow  
or Matthias Williams at any time after due note & on demand issued to sell the above named  
property by giving ten days publick Notice of the time and place of such sale and with  
the proceeds of such sale to the said Everett is just to pay all expenses attending the sale of  
and defending of his Indenture and expenses attending the sale then the debt above named  
or so much of it as may be at that time due and stand there then to be remanded to him  
pay such remainder to the said John Blow or his executors and garnish the said property  
to whom in the event of death of the said John Blow until the day of sale or so long as  
he may remain in the County of Southampton or his executors or garnish the said  
the day and year above written
