 date and being willing and desirous to give the same into absolute William has been glad
 to have then day granted bargain sold made over and Confirmed and by these presents to give
 grant bargain sell make over and Refund unto William L. Everett and his representatives
 and for the further return of our dollar to him in hand paid by the said Matthias
 L. Everett the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following property to wit one
 Bay mare one Cart and a wheel two beds and furniture one Car and Cart one on two doors
 and pig and eight sheep and the the said John Blom warrants and forever defends the
 aforesaid property against the claim and demand of all and every other person or persons unto
 him the said William L. Everett and his representatives &c. Notwithstanding that
 in the said Court shall upon the request of either of the above named parties John Blom
 or Matthias Williams at any time after said Test. is Or demand issued to sell the above named
 property by giving ten days public notice of the time and place of such sale and only
