 Cordell Brantley of the County of Southampton of the first part Henry Moore of the said County of the second part and
 Thomas Moore of the said County of the third part Whereas the said Cordell Brantley is justly indebted to the
 said Henry Moore the sum of fifty seven dollars and fifty Cents and the said Cordell Brantley being willing
 and desirous to secure to the said Thomas Moore the payment thereof together with the legal interest thereon according
 and also the Cost of drawing and recording and carrying into effect these presents. Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Cordell Brantley in consideration of the premises and also the further consideration of one dollar
 to him now paid by the said Henry Moore the said Cordell Brantley hath granted bargained sold and
 by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Moore his heirs and assigns forever the following
 negroes to wit one negro Girl Amy and one boy Tom To have and to hold the aforesaid negroes unto him
 the said Henry Moore his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry Moore
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said Cordell Brantley for himself his heirs Executors and administrators
 Covenant and agrees to and with the said Henry Moore that he will from time to time and at all times
 forever perform Warrant and defend the title of the aforesaid negroes unto the said Henry Moore
 his heirs and assigns forever Upon Special Trial and Confession of Mischief and to and for the use
 intents and purposes following. Viz that he the said Henry Moore or any of his heirs or assigns whenever he shall
 be thereto requested make sale of the aforesaid negroes at publick sale to pay and satisfy the debt entered
 on the aforesaid first advertisement the day and place of sale at the Buckhams of the County of said and at
 such other publick places as he the said Henry Moore may think proper so as to render complete
 justice to the parties ten days previous to the ready money and out of the proceeds of such sale
 pay unto the said Henry Moore his heirs and assigns the sum of fifty seven dollars and
 fifty Cents together with the interest thereon and Cost of the carrying into effect these presents
