George Whifford and Tolly his wife conveys a deed for to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs
and assigns bearing date the 17th day of February in the year of our Lord 1823. the boundaries of which parcel
fully appear by referring to the said deed which is now of record in the Clerks office for the County aforesaid.
furthermore he the said Davis Bryant upon Consideration as aforesaid and the said George Whifford and
Tolly his wife have in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars due to them in hand
paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the executing and delivery of this present the full
amount whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain
and sell unto him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say they the said Davis
Bryant George Whifford and Tolly his wife have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant
bargain and sell unto him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns two certain parcels lots of
Land lying on the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows, to wit on one side
Lots or parcels of land so bounded that beginning in the forks of the main branch called Fish Creek and along
Rome Road thence nearly a Southward Course along the center of the said River called Rome the said
Road separating a line between the said George Whifford and Tolly his wife on one part and the said
Jacob Barnes on the other so far as the Line of the said George Whifford and Tolly his wife extends
along said Road the extent of which is to the Banks of Catherine's Run thence nearly a Southward Course
along said Run to a post oak a corner on said Run thence thence nearly east Course along said
Run to the Bank belonging to the Methodist Episcopal Church thence nearly a north Course
along said Members line to the said Jacob Barnes line same Course along said Run to the
