And in case the said Jacob Barnes shall die before the execution of this trust his Executors or administrators shall carry the Indenture into effect and of operation and the said Matthew Story doth hereby warrant and defend the right and title of the above named property and then the said Jacob Barnes the Executors and administrators against himself his Executors and administrators and also against the claim of all and every person or persons claiming in the title of which the parties hereto have subscribed their names entered the same by their heirs officers or the day and year herein first above Express Sailed and

I Corinnus Pickles of Southampton County and State of Virginia having under my care a negro woman named Edy aged about thirty two years who has been legally on a State of Slavery but being of opinion that it is my duty to do to others as I would be done by therefore I do hereby emancipate and set free the said Edy And I as for myself my heirs Executors administrators assigns relinquish all my right title interest and claim or pretension of claim whatsoever either to her person or to any estate she may hereafter acquire the above named Edy and her posterity to enjoy their full freedom without any interruption from me or any person claiming for or on our side. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of the 9th month in the year of our Lord 1824.
