 Corp of Spotsylvania County Virginia of the third part Whereas the said Richard Musgrave party on the first
 the said Hardy Corp on the second of one thousand seven hundred and some dollars to be paid on the 30th
 day of December next ensuing as by bill with legal interest thereon accruing the said Richard Musgrave - writing
 and decess to some With this Indenture together with the bill and consideration of the premises also for and
 consideration of one dollar to the said Richard Musgrave hand paid by the said William M. Jones at and
 before the executing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the said Richard
 Musgrave had granted bargained and sold and as to by these presents granted bargained and sold and Confessed to the
 said William M. Jones his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land called and known by the
 name of Little Town tract lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and on the West side of
 Black Creek River containing four hundred and twenty six and three fourth acres more or less marked &
 bounded as follows Beginning at a point on the Bank of Black water near Cross of Mrs. Gardner thence out
 102 1/2 poles to a pine stump 100 poles to a red oak thence 102 1/2 poles to a pine stump thence 102
 thence 102 poles to a long red Cedar and 102 poles thence to a pine stump thence 102 poles to a
 10 3/4 poles to a white oak standing in the above named a corner thence 102 poles to a long red
 French the several corners thereof 102 poles to a maple thence thence out East 9 poles to a pine stump thence 102 poles
 to a red oak thence 10 1/4 poles to a stake thence North 101 poles to black water River of record thence down
 and down the river corner thence to the first station another tract called the person tract containing two
 hundred and some or less adjoining the lands of William M. Jones Mathew Gardner and others the several corners
 remainder and remainings of said several tracts of land and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof
 to have and to hold the said lands or parcels of Land with the premises and appurtenances before written
