This Indenture made this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and twenty two, between Anthony Williamson of Southampton County of the one part and  
Edmund Taper of the same County of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of  
four hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Taper the receipt whereof the said  
Anthony Williamson doth hereby acknowledge is fully granted bargained and sold sufficient and sufficient  
and by these presents do grant, bargain sell alway and confer unto the said Edmund Taper his heirs and  
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres to them the dimensions  
thereof being and lying in the County of Southampton on Black Creek road and bounded as follows: By  
beginning at a corner on Penruddle Boundary thence to a black Gum a corner tree in Pleasant  
Clark's line and from thence to a Person on tree on the said Ticks line thence down the line a straight  
line to a post oak a corner tree in John Dows line thence along a line of Chapel trees to a pine tree in the  
corner tree in Gipsy Creek line thence along the said Creek line to the swamp thence to a red oak in the  
said Creek line thence to a small oak a corner tree in Weeks line thence to a post oak in the  
same line and from thence across the road to the beginning \$100000.00 to have the said tract  
of Land with the appurtenances unto the said Edmund Taper or his heirs together with all profits  
commodities and advantages and incidentments whatsoever also the use and possession to him and his  
heirs and assigns of the said Land and premises and of every part thereof and also the title  
right and title interest claim and demand whatsoever of the said Anthony Williamson and his heirs Corp  
Rockell the said Edmund also mentioned and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said  
Edmund Taper his heirs and assigns to the only proper and true title of the said Edmund Taper  
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Anthony Williamson and his heirs the said premises  
and every part and parcel thereof against their heirs and against all and every other person or party  
whatsoever claiming or pretension to claim any right title or interest to the said Land shall have
