This Indenture made this 18th day of July in the year of Christ 1734. Between Nathaniel Young and Mary his wife of the County of Staffordshire and State of Virginia of the one part and Edwin Parks of the County of Southampton and State of Maryland of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Young and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty pounds acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened released and conveyed and by their presents do grant bargain sell alien release of off and convey unto the said Edwin Parks one certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the said County of Southampton containing by a late survey one hundred and fifty acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit part of the tract of Land formerly belonging to Alexander M^{rs} which said land conveyed to the said Young by William Taylor a deed for which is of record in the office of said County of Southampton reference being thereunto had well more fully appearing the title thereof together with all the appurtenances to the same land belonging or in any way appertaining to the said Edwin Parks has here and assigns forever to have and to hold the said Land with its appurtenances and the reason and reason thereunto and to his heirs and assigns forever and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Edwin Parks his heirs and assigns and the said Nathaniel Young and Mary his wife do hereby covenant and with the said Edwin Parks has here and assigns the said land and all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Edwin Parks has here and assigns forever to warrant and forever defend against the title claim and demand of them the said Nathaniel Young and Mary R. his wife their heirs executors and administrators and against the title claim and demand of persons from whom by their presents given In witness whereof the said Nathaniel Young and Mary R. his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first here written
