This Indenture made the first day of November in the year of our Lord Christ 1824
Between James Myrick and Thos. Myrick his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
of the one part and Thomas Paddy of the same County and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said
James Myrick and Thos. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twenty
dollars Current money of the Commonwealth to them on hand paid by the said Thomas Paddy
at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the
said Thomas Paddy and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke
Containing by the Survey of J. J. and a half acres to the same more or less
and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake oak a corner of said Thomas Paddy's land thence along the
line of said Paddy's land 122.50 poles to a pine a corner of said Edwin Pollock's land thence along the
line of said Paddy's land 122.50 poles to a pine thence N. 15 1/2 E. 50 poles thence S. 22. E. 7 1/2
poles to a corner on said Thomas Paddy's line thence N. 66. 1/2 W. 62 poles to a pine thence N. 60
W. 22 poles thence N. 66. 1/2 W. 35 poles to a stake oak a corner of said Thomas Paddy's
in said Edwin Pollock's line thence along said Pollock's line S. 23. 1/2 W. 12 poles thence S. 22
W. 57 poles to a stake oak thence S. 22. 1/2 W. 16 poles thence S. 10. 1/2 W. 11 poles to the beginning together
with all tenies out Tenies Ditches woods ways water and water Courses whatsoever belonging or
any use appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the said Thomas Paddy
to him and to his heirs forever and the said James Myrick and Thos. his wife do hereby
their heirs Executors admors and assigns do for them their heirs &c. Covenant and grant to and
with the said Thomas Paddy his heirs Executors admors or assigns that they will by these
presents warrant and forever defend all the right title claim and demand of or in to the said tract or
parcel of Land and premises against the lawful claims or demands of all and every person or persons
whatsoever In witness whereof the said James Myrick and Thos. Myrick his wife have hereunto
set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first within written

of the one part and Spradley Tapp of the other part witnesseth that the said John Tapp
for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twenty dollars to him on hand paid by the said
Spradley Tapp the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said John Tapp
bargain and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto and confirm unto the
said Spradley Tapp and to his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the same County of Southampton
By Estimation Fifty acres to the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton
on the north side of Crossford Road and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a large hickory
in the north side of Crossford Road and thence as follows to wit beginning at a large hickory
Indian branch thence up the said branch to a stone Tapp's line thence a short course
to a white oak standing at Crossford's was thence along the said road to the beginning
of being the land whereon the said Spradley Tapp now resides to have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the aforesaid names unto the
said Spradley Tapp and his heirs &c. and the said John Tapp for himself his heirs &c.
