of the one part and Thomas Ridley of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said
James Myrick and Thos. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twenty
dollars Current money of the Commonwealth to them on hand paid by the said Thomas Ridley
at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the
said Thomas Ridley and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke
Containing by late Survey fifty Six and a half acres to the same more or less
and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a stake oak a corner of said Thomas Ridley's land thence along the
line of said E. S. pole to a pine a corner of said Edwin Pittway's land thence along the
line of said E. S. pole to a white oak a corner of said Thomas Ridley's land thence along the
line of said Thomas Ridley's land thence N. 22. E. 20 poles to a pine thence N. 18 1/2 E. 50 poles thence N. 22. E. 7 1/2
poles to a corner on said Thomas Ridley's land thence N. 16. 60 poles to a pine thence N. 63
W. 32 poles thence N. 66. 60. 30. poles to a dead oak a corner of said Thomas Ridley's
land thence Edwin Pittway's land thence along said Pittway's line S. 21. N. 100 1/2 poles thence S. 20
W. 57 poles to a red oak thence S. 23. 60. 16. poles thence S. 10. 26 1/2 poles to the beginning together
with all houses out houses fixtures woods ways waters and water courses whatsoever belonging or
any use appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto the said Thomas Ridley

bargain and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto him the said Spradley Tape
the tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
by late Survey fifty six and a half acres to the same more or less
on the North Side of Crossford Road and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a large hickory
forming part of the line between the said John Tape and the said Edwin Pittway's land thence
