Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred seven dollars and sixty three Cents due by bond bearing date the 2nd day of Novr 1822 as well as for the further consideration of one dollar which has paid by the said Arthur Meddleton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Ellis to the said James Ellis hath granted bargain and sell unto the said Arthur Meddleton and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Arthur Meddleton to him and his heirs forever the following piece of Land to wit the parcel of Land lying and being as aforesaid more or less as appears from their Trade records that it is the true intent and meaning of this presents that at any time hereafter when required by the said Edwards Betts or the said James Ellis shall request after advertising the same and placing the same at least ten days the said Arthur Meddleton his heirs executors and admors shall proceed to sell the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land as aforesaid or as much of it as may be sufficient to pay the aforesaid debt interest and costs and the surplus of any payment to the said James Ellis or such other person or persons as he shall see charge in writing to receive the same.
