was made by the hands of Peter Sommerville and Robert Doughty both of the witnesses thereunto and continued
and in the Clerk's office the 1st November 1824. This Indenture as aforesaid was fully paid by the
witnesses of William Compton the other with his seals and admitted to record and then countersigned for the
aforesaid County of Southampton, given on the 1st November 1824. This Indenture as aforesaid was also
countermarked by the Clerk of the said County of Southampton on the 1st November 1824.

This Indenture made and entered into on the 18th day of August 1823 Robert Doughty of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the first part John Spencer of the same County and State of the second part
and Lewis Morris of the same County and State of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Robert Doughty
stands party neither by a note of hand to the said John Spencer in the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars bearing
own date with three per cent and whereas the further appearance of the payment is agreed by the parties
herein that a sum of money in trust shall be made to the said John Spencer for the benefit of the said
