

This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of April in the year of our Lord 1834 between *Elly Porter* of the first part Benjamin Giffen of the second part and Henry Porter of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesses that the said *Elly Porter* for and in consideration of one hundred eighty four dollars which said sum is due from the said *Elly Porter* to the said *Henry Porter* by bond bearing date the 17th day of April 1834 as well as all other moneys and charges from the said *Elly Porter* to the said *Henry Porter* by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatever as also for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to be in hand paid to the said *Benjamin Giffen* the receipt whereof the said *Elly Porter* did hereby acknowledge and she and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said *Benjamin Giffen* and his heirs forever all right title interest in the place half and more or less and bounded by the lands of William Stephens James Banger John Lewis John Stephens and others being the tract of land being situate under a deed intended to satisfy Benjamin Giffen John and his heirs the right and interest of the said tract of land thence conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said *Benjamin Giffen* and of any force upon this special bond recited that the said *Benjamin Giffen* of one being after advertising the land and place in the said County of Southampton further any persons at some publick house or place for cash and out of the money coming out of from the said debt in the first place pay and satisfy all debt owing the said debt as well as the expense attending the said conveyance and then pay off the bond and any with interest as well as all other moneys which may appear to be due and owing from the said *Elly Porter* to the said *Henry Porter* by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatever and the surplus of any pay to the said *Elly Porter* and the said *Elly Porter* two times and assigne forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawful claims claims of the said *Elly Porter* his heirs Executors and admors against all and every other person persons persons persons and thence *Benjamin Giffen* in these presents and agreed that he doth make void of the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the land after advertising the same and place for the days for years at some publick house or store in the said County and within the money coming from the said first pay and satisfy all debt due and owing as all other moneys which may appear to the said *Henry Porter* to be justly due and owing from the said *Elly Porter* to the said *Henry Porter* by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatever and then pay the surplus of any to the said *Elly Porter* and the said *Henry Porter* in his last presents and agrees that he doth release the said *Elly Porter* from the obligation of this indenture upon the said *Elly Porter* paying him the amount of the above said debt with interest as well as all other moneys which may be due and owing to him the said *Henry Porter* by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatever he satisfy whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of

This Indenture made and entered into on the 18th day of August 1834 between *Robert Daugherty* of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part John Spencer of the same County and State of the second part and Lewis Morrill of the same County and State of the third part witnesses that whereas the said *Robert Daugherty* stands partly indebted by a note of hand to the said *John Spencer* in the sum of the sum and being four dollars bearing date with their presents and whereas the further appearance of the payment it is agreed by the parties hereto that an conveyance in trust shall be made to the said *John Spencer* for the benefit of the said *Lewis Morrill* to secure the said debt.
