and incosideration of the premises and for the further sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is by me acknowledged and signed and by these presents will for himself his heirs executors and administrators give grant to the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns all the plantation house and part of land wherein the said Robert Daugthy now lies Containing by estimation thirty five acres of land to be the same mannerly and bounded by the said Morell and his heirs bounds. Part of and also all the buildings woods timber advantages appertaining to the same or in anywise belonging and all the estate rights and titles of him the said Robert Daugthy by grant and to the same. To have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with every of the appurtenances unto him the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns in trust forever and to be held subject to the true intent and meaning of these presents that of the said Robert Daugthy shall punctually pay unto the said Morell his heirs and assigns the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars and interest agreed to be due to the said Morell of and to the said Lewis Morell then the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns shall hold the said lands to the sole and proper use and benefit of the said Robert Daugthy and his heirs Robert Daugthy shall fail to pay the said Lewis Morell the above mentioned debt and interest amount theron when demanded by the said Lewis Morell then the said John Spencer at the request of the said Lewis Morell shall advertise and sell the above described tract of land for ready money (after giving) ten days previous notice of the time and place of sale and from the proceeds of said sale first pay and satisfy the same. Then Morell the amount of the said debt and all interest and cost thereon amount and the surplus if any the said John Spencer his heirs to shall pay over to the said Robert Daugthy his heirs executors and assigns and the said Robert Daugthy shall have warrant of arrest to file the said tract of land from any person or persons claiming thereto through him unto the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns forever. Hart at or before the recording) and delivery of this present do receipt that the said Benjamin Hart return my said lands given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Benjamin D.

Dear Sirs and assigns forever the following property tract of land which I the said John Hart do now bear and reside in in the aforesaid County of Southampton Containing by estimation one hundred and forty acres or thereabouts be the same mannerly it being all the lands which I the said John Hart do own in the aforesaid County of Southampton and the County of Essex adjoining to the lands of John J. Hart and others one hundred and sixteen acres with their fixtures in excess of forty acres Stock of Horses Cattle hogs and Sheep all my household and kitchen furniture all my plantations utensils of every description and kind dinner and all my tools of every kind as I now possess on the plantation and also every part and particle of my Estate of whatsoever kind or nature so long as I live. To have and to hold unto the said Benjamin D. Hart his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John Hart for himself his heirs and assigns and the said Benjamin Hart his heirs and assigns and against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and will appear and demand before them by these presents In witness whereof the said Joshua Hart has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the 1st day of October 1828.
