 above Landed goods and the above Landed Stock and woods or any other person whatsoever
 from laying any claim unto the above Landed property which S. the said Mary Brown in and my Hens
 Cows and Pigeons and dependents from the said Pys. Sumner and the Hens, Cows and Pigeons
 which I have hereto set my Hand and Seal this 13th day of November in the year of our Lord

This Indenture made and entered into on this 1st day of October in the year of our Lord 1837 between John Fickel first
 part Augustin Pope of the second part and Sam. Pagan of the third part each of the three above named parties trustee of the
 County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Whereas the said John Fickel stands party in virtue to the said Sam. Pagan
 in the sum of Twenty five Dollars and Forty one Cents appearing by bond bearing date with this indenture payable on
 demand the payment of which together with the interest which shall accrue thereon the said John Fickel according and
 demands effectually to appear and answer to the said Sam. Pagan This Condition Whosoever it that
 the said John Fickel as well in consideration of the premises as of the sum of four dollars current money of the United
 States to him taken and paid by the said Augustin Pope at and before the making and delivery of these presents
 the said Augustin Pope has acknowledged and given every part of which the said Augustin Pope and all
 his legal representatives are forever released discharged and discharged him granted bargained and sold and do
 by these presents hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Augustin Pope his heirs and assigns as follows
 that to wit the said John Fickel has granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Augustin Pope his heirs and assigns one Certain tract or Parcel of Land lying and being
 within the County of Southampton and bounded by the Limits of the following named persons to wit
 George Williams Mary Jones the said Augustin Pope Mrs. Fennell Mrs. Fickel Mrs. Fickel Mrs. Fickel
 North and the above named Sam. Pagan of being the land between the said John Fickel now then said to contain
 twenty five acres of land be the same more or less and all and singularly the appurtenances thereto in every
 manner belonging or appertaining and all the right title interest and estate which of them the said John Fickel
 of and to the same do him the said Augustin Pope his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever to the only people
 use and behoof of them the said Augustin Pope his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and that of
 the said John Fickel his heirs executors administrators shall well and truly pay to the said Sam. Pagan his heirs and
 assigns the aforesaid sum of Twenty five Dollars and Forty one Cents with the interest which shall have
 accrued thereon or before the time the said Sam. Pagan his heirs executors administrators and assigns shall or may require
 the payment of the above named debt and interest which shall have accrued thereon and that they the said
 here and every thing herein contained is to be void and of no effect but of the said John Fickel
