 Tapp to the discharge of the apportioned debt and owing to the said Jacob Barne as aforesaid
 and any surplus of money thereafter remaining in the hands of the said Augustine Tapp is to be paid over to
 the said John Vick his heirs Executors or administrators and in case the said debt should not be paid over to
 him or the sale thereof the said Augustine Tapp shall release to the said John Vick all the title shown being
 transferred to him and in case the said Augustine Tapp shall die before the execution of his Trust his
 Executors or administrators shall carry this Indenture into effect and execution and the said John Vick
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns be bound to and with the said Augustine Tapp
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that the aforesaid John Vick shall not and do not
 therefore warrant and defend unto him the said Augustine Tapp his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
 the right title interest and estate of or to the before described tract of land against him or his

This Indenture made this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 thirty four and between Eliza Bate of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one
 part Carr Bowers of the same County and State of the second part and Eliza Bate
 of the aforesaid State and County of the third part Witnesseth that Whereas the said Eliza Bate
 is fully indebted to the aforesaid Carr Bowers in sum of eighty two dollars and twenty one pence as appears
 by a note duly executed from the said Eliza Bate to the said Carr Bowers in the sum aforesaid and
 made payable on or before the 27th day of December next ensuing and whereas the said Eliza Bate
 is willing and desirous to secure to the said Carr Bowers the said debt due to the said Carr Bowers from
 her and the several owners of the premises but more especially for and in consideration of four dollars
 to him in hand paid by the said Eliza Bate to the said Carr Bowers before the execution and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof the said Carr Bowers has given and acknowledged and also that
 these presents with bargain grant and release the said Eliza Bate before her heirs and assigns the following
 property To wit one Horse Cart and wheels three feather beds and furniture with all my household
 and kitchen furniture of whatsoever kind four head of Cattle three Sows and seven lambs with all
 my farming utensils and all my other property of all kind. To have and to hold the said property
 above described unto the said Eliza Bate her heirs and assigns forever but upon the special
 trust and condition that the said Eliza Bate her heirs and assigns shall process to sell and
 let to sale the aforesaid Horse Cart and wheels two Cattle two Sows and seven lambs
