This Indenture made this second day of August Eighteen hundred and twenty four between William Lawrence of the one part and John Margrave of the other part witnesseth that the said William E Lawrence con consideration of their summes and the deuise current money of to him in hand paid by the said John Margrave his hars bargained and seaued and by this present Indenture doth give and sell unto the said John Margrave his hars and afterys a certain tract or parcel of land containing by dimensions nearly two acres & yds long the lot or parcel of land aforesaid purchased by the said John Margrave of Henry T Magrath esqre appurteyning by and now of acres and bounded by the land of Henry T Magrath and the apurteyning John Margrave together with the common and diverses boundaries and dimensions of yds and other parts appurteyning and proper and in full thereof To Ross and C. hole the said tract or parcel of land with the tenementes thereon and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained for and every part and parcel therof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said John Margrave his heirs and assigns forever And the said William E Lawrence furthering and giveth the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto unto the said John Margrave his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said William E Lawrence and his heirs and of all and every person whatsoever excepting any claim which Mrs Magrath wife of Henry Magrath may hereafter set up to one third part of said parcel of land for her legal dower in the same he before mentioned William Lawrence having purchased the same subject to such claim and more dallyng it in like manner shall well and do remeint and forever defend during the life of the said William E Lawrence heremint set the Land and what there lay and doth above written legacies & debts excepting of Madam William the Esqre his wife T. J. Maher William Lawrence

This Indenture made this 8 day of September 1824 Between Richard P. Pope Jr. alias P. Pope his wife Honora Pope Phebe Johnson Edmund Spencer and Sophia Pope of the County of Southampton the party first and Barnwell Jones of the said County of the other witnesseth that the said Richard P. Pope his wife Honora Pope Phebe Johnson Edmund Spencer and Sophia Pope for Land and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them undelivered by the said Barnwell Jones the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged back bargained to us above enfristed and Conforms unto the said Barnwell Jones and to his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid and measuring by estimation forty four acres a half acre more or less and bounded on the south west by a corner made between them in a Cleft called Barnwell Cleft hence along the line of a rock wall 10 1/2 poles thence 10 3/4 poles to a tree to a black oak corner of said estimation and Richard P. Pope aforesaid and his wife Honora Pope 10 1/2 W 13 poles thence 10 3/4 N 11 poles thence 10 1/2 E 14 poles thence 10 1/2 N 8 1/2 W 12 poles thence N 70 1/2 E 15 1/2 poles to a stone fence a corner made between Richard P. Pope and Phebe Johnson Edmund Spouse aforesaid thence along said fence line 8 3/4 N 11 poles thence 5 3/4 W 11 poles to a fence near the head of a small branch thence down the run of the branch 8 8 poles thence S 5 1/2 E 6 poles thence E 6 poles S 2 E 6 poles E 2 E 2 poles S 2 E 6 poles S 6 E 6 poles S 3 E 6 poles S 16 E 8 poles S 2 E 4 poles due South 3 poles to a group of trees a corner made between said Richard P. Pope Jr. alias P. Pope his wife Honora Pope Phebe Johnson Edmund Spencer and Sophia Pope and Barnwell Jones thence along a new line of marked trees 17 1/2 E 7 1/2 poles to the first stake all the right lette 1/2 of an acre to the said land and plantation thence the said Richard P. Pope Jr. alias P. Pope his wife Honora Pope Phebe Johnson Edmund Spencer to have and to hold the said tract and parcel of land and premises with all appurtenances unto the said Barnwell Jones his heirs forever to the person and behalf of the said Richard P. Barnwell Jones and the said Richard P. Pope Jr. alias P. Pope his wife Honora Pope Phebe Johnson Edmund Spencer
