I call to whom these present shall come whereas George Williams of Southampton County by his due and entire bearing date the 21st day of June 1799 did sell and convey unto Joseph Traylor and his heirs and assigns a tract of land Situate lying and being on the County aforesaid for the Consideration and securing the payment of one hundred and fifty dollars and interest thereon due by note to James Lott from the said George Williams with a right of preemption on the payment thereof to the said James Lott his heirs or assigns and whereas the said George Williams hath paid and satisfied the said James Lott the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and interest thereon to the said James Lott his heirs or assigns and whereas the said Joseph Traylor for the Consideration aforesaid have and by his presents do release and forever quit claim unto the said George Williams and his heirs and assigns all the right title interest claim or demand from the said Joseph Traylor my heirs executors and administrators of or to the aforesaid tract of land And I do hereby request and discharge the said George Williams his heirs executors and administrators from the said debt and demand with my hand and seal this 23 day of November 1824
