Mr. Lawrence Cook and David Thomas Jurors of the peace for the County of Southampton aforesaid do hereby certify that Maria A. Everett wife of William L. Everett formerly from day appears before us in our County aforesaid and being examined and sworn by her husband after having the said fully explained to her. She acknowledged the said act and deed and that she had in due and legal manner the same and was not to retract from it. Given under our hands and seals this 5th day of December 1834.

Everett wife of William Everett parties thereto and admitted to record and also certified for the Superior County of Southampton on the 2d Decem^r 1834. This Indenture entered into this 18th September 1834. Between Richard Harper of the first part and Benjamin Chorson of the second part witnesseth that whereas the said Benjamin Chorson having become the owner of the said Richard Harper on a bond vacated by them to John W. Chorson the sum of one hundred dollars payable on demand and the said Richard wishing to withdraw the said Benjamin from and ensure a discharge of the same and also for an accommodation of one dollar to him in his said bond by the said David Thomas Juror granted to and by their present assent granted Benjamin and sold to the said David Thomas Juror all the stock of large Corn Crops of all the growing Crops of Corn, field and Cotton and all other Crops of the present year growing or about to be taken on within one month on the Farm where the same are to be and to be the same on the premises by them the said Chorson then after Benjamin and sold the said Benjamin and agreed that the said Benjamin to be the possessor of and exercise the sole management and decision during the life of the said Richard and until the Crops shall be harvested and at that time will upon the request of the said Benjamin do the same or wait for Cash as he himself may think best and out of the proceeds pay the said debt to John W. Chorson provided the same be then due or make such other arrangement as may be agreeable to all parties and the balance of the said Benjamin and the said Benjamin Chorson to manage the same as continued to be in his own and to retain to the said Richard his rights upon the subject of the Indenture being accomplished. Witnesseth the parties thereto at their houses and seals the day and year above written.

And in the Clerk's office the 21st November 1834. This Indenture was finally by the order of James Nichols and the Clerk of the said County of Southampton the 17th January 1835. This Indenture as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings of the day.
